SUBJECT: OCARTS Area Project List Utilizing American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Funds

INFORMATION:

At its regular March meeting, the ITTC recommended approval of a funding distribution plan for the region's \$33.67 million in upcoming American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds, also known as Stimulus funds. The recommended plan ensures that each OCARTS area entity that desires to participate will receive a portion of the Stimulus funding based on its share of population, with all entities receiving at least \$225,000 regardless of size. Attached is the revised **funding distribution plan** that reflects all of the participating entities and their funding allocation.

ACOG staff also provided the ITTC with a **Stimulus Packet** that included the requirements for getting the projects reviewed and cleared for bid letting by ODOT. OCARTS member entities were asked to carefully review the packet and provide its final list of "ready to go" stimulus projects to ACOG by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19, 2009. The following information was requested for each project:

- Project location – street name
- Project limits – from and to termini
- Project description – e.g. resurfacing
- Estimated total cost for construction only

The final project list will be available at the Special ITTC meeting on March 24.
