I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

Chairman John G. Johnson called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. He introduced himself and entertained introductions around the room. There was a quorum.

II. APPROVAL OF THE OCTOBER 13, 2016 MINUTES

Harry Fenton moved to approve the October 13, 2016 meeting minutes. Angelo Lombardo seconded the motion. The motion carried.

III. <u>ACTION ITEMS:</u>

A. <u>Consider recommending that the ITPC amend the FFY 2017–FFY 2020 elements of the OCARTS Area TIP by replacing the currently listed ODOT projects with the attached projects.</u>

Chairman Johnson said "Handout — Attachment III-A" was available at the table with the updated project information that will be voted on today.

John Sharp said the Oklahoma Transportation Commission approved a new 8-Year Construction Work Plan for ODOT, and the first four years of the 8-Year Plan will be incorporated into the FFY 2017-2020 STIP. He said that to ensure consistency between the FFY 2017-2020 OCARTS Area TIP and the latest funding priorities reflected in the 8-Year Construction Work Plan and STIP, it is requested that the FFY 2017-2020 state highway system shaded projects reflected in the handout be added to the ODOT projects currently listed in the OCARTS TIP. Mr. Sharp said that approval of these amendments will not impact the region's STP-UZA funds available for use by OCARTS area local governments.

Harry Fenton moved to recommend that the ITPC amend the FFY 2017—FFY 2020 elements of the OCARTS Area TIP by replacing the currently listed 0D0T projects with the attachment handout of the projects. Angelo Lombardo seconded the motion. The motion carried.

B. <u>Motion to set date and time for special meeting of the ITTC to review and rank STP-UZA projects proposed for updating the current FFY 2017-2020 OCARTS Area TIP.</u>

After discussion, Harry Fenton moved to set date and time for special meeting of the ITTC to review and rank STP-UZA projects proposed for updating the current FFY 2017-2020 OCARTS Area TIP for 9:30 a.m. Thursday, January 19, 2017. Angelo Lombardo seconded the motion. The motion carried.

C. <u>Consider recommending that the ITPC approve the proposed 2017 ITTC meeting</u> schedule.

After some discussion, Harry Fenton moved to recommend that the ITPC approve the proposed 2017 ITTC meeting schedule. Commissioner Marven Goodman seconded the motion. The motion carried.

IV. ITEMS FOR INFORMATION ONLY:

A. <u>Open Streets OKC October 2016 Report</u>

Charlotte Adcock gave a presentation on the Open Streets OKC Event that was held Sunday, October 23, from 1-5 p.m. on South Robinson Ave. She said Embark staff showed how to load and unload bicycles on the buses. There were many activities along the route, as well as food trucks. Spokies staff was available to show their new bikes and ODOT staff handed out information on how to walk and ride safely.

Ms. Adcock said total attendance was estimated at 15,000 participants. Ava Beeby asked how that estimate compared to the N. 23rd Street Open Streets events. John Sharp said the N. 23rd Street events started with an estimated 20,000 participants the first year, 30,000 the second year, and 40,000 last year. He said this event at S. Robinson Avenue from SW 15th Street to SW 29th Street started with 5,000 last year, and with the added marketing techniques this year, that is why there was a big jump in participants. C. <u>2017 Oklahoma Recreational Trails Program</u>

John Sharp said the 2017 Oklahoma Recreational Trails Program grant applications are due January 31, 2017. He said Committee members could go to the link in the agenda which would take them to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department site where it will tell how to fill out the form, what is eligible and what is not. He said eligible projects can be vegetation, bathrooms, lighting, fencing, bike racks, bridges (i.e. in a park), etc. He suggested that they contact Susan Henry before getting too far in the process to make sure their project can be considered. He said a public meeting was necessary to involve the public in the project, so that was the reason for getting this information out as soon as possible. Mr. Sharp noted that the Oklahoma City Community Foundation [OCCF] might be able to help with a local match in regards to trees, landscaping, etc.

D. <u>OCARTS Area Line Item Projects</u>

John Sharp said this is an informational item identifying three specific FFY 2017 OCARTS projects that were previously included in statewide line items, and the second table reflects an FFY 2017 administrative modification affecting an OCARTS area STIP project.

E. <u>Status of Surface Transportation Program Urbanized Area (STP-UZA) Projects in the OCARTS Transportation Management Area (TMA)</u>

John Sharp said this is the monthly status report on STP-UZA projects in the OCARTS TMA. He noted that the lists reflect:

- 1) The FFY 2017-2020 projects
- 2) Potential FFY 2021-2023 projects, as part of an eight-year plan, which allows 0D0T to continue environmental review
- 3) The unscheduled projects which are programmed but not in the TIP

He said Chad Meisenburg of ODOT was here today to talk with anyone who needed to review the status of their FFY 2017 STP-UZA projects in the FFY 2017-FFY 2020 TIP.

Chairman Johnson asked if there was any new business to be presented. No new business was brought forward.

INFORMATION:

In late October, ACOG staff received news of a deadline for compliance with the requirements of <u>23 CFR 511 [Real-Time System Management Information Program - RTSMIP]</u> coming up in November for metropolitan areas over 1 million in MSA population. This was to establish RTSMIP on State-designated Routes-of-Significance (per 23 CFR 511.303) and send the assessment to FHWA **no later than November 4** using the following guide:

- Yes Establishment of RTSMIP processes for Routes-of-Significance
- Partial Routes-of-Significance identified; processes in-place to incorporate some/most routes and a path forward identified to establish such processes (with brief explanation, e.g. pending establishment of process with local agency, acquisition process underway, etc.)
- No Not Compliant (with brief explanation of gaps)


The initial request for this information was made to Alan Stevenson, Assistant Division Engineer, ODOT. Mr. Stevenson coordinated with ACOG staff to determine corridors, not on the interstate system, that would be "Routes of Significance." The RTSMIP requirements would be at a "Partial" status by the assessment guideline definitions. ODOT will incorporate in their process a system to monitor and document for the following conditions.

- Road or lane closures because of construction, traffic incidents, or other events
- Roadway weather or other environmental conditions restricting or adversely affecting travel
- Travel times or speeds on limited access roadways in metropolitan areas that experience recurring congestion

The attached map includes map "Routes-of-Significance" highlighted. The routes are as follows:

INFORMATION:

In 2014, ACOG initiated a call for TAP projects. This MAP-21 funding was for FFY 2013 and FFY 2014 and was approximately \$2.8M.

In 2017, ACOG will have another call for TAP projects. At the September Bicycle-Pedestrian Advisory Committee meeting, ODOT's Chad Meisenburg stated that there would be at least \$8.4 million available for TAP funding in the OCARTS adjusted Urban Area. The committee was asked if they would prefer three or six years of TAP funding. The committee decided on six years (FY 2015 to FY2020).

At the December 7 Bicycle-Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) meeting, the committee will decide whether to use an updated <u>TAP Instructions and Application</u> package that was utilized for the FFY 2013 and FFY 2014 funding cycle, or appoint a BPAC subcommittee to develop a new document. The results of this BPAC meeting will be provided at the ITTC meeting.
