RURAL ECONOMIC ACTION PLAN (REAP) GRANTS



REAP grants are available to towns in the ACOG region (Canadian, Cleveland, Logan and Oklahoma counties) with a population under 6,999. The funds come through the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and they require no match. ACOG can help small municipalities receive up to up to \$100,000, usually applied to water, public works, healthcare, or road projects.
