## INFORMATION:

The Recreational Trails Program (RTP) is a federal-aid program administered by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department (OTRD). This grant program is part of the Transportation Alternatives formula funding. The RTP provides for 80 percent federal share and requires a 20 percent local match. The match may be either in cash or in value of documented contributions. Other sources of federal funds may also be used for the match up to 95 percent of the total project cost.

The application deadline is 4 p.m. on Tuesday, January 31, 2023. The application and further information are available on the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department website, <https://otrd.travelok.com/about-otrd/get-involved/>. This year, the maximum grant amount is \$300,000 (with at least a \$75,000 match), for a total project cost of \$375,000.

Please carefully read the application forms for specific requirements. Additional information will be required for applications involving land acquisition.

### INFORMATION:

ACOG opened the FY 2023 Call for Projects for the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) on September 1, 2022.

This program intends to provide funding for projects that advance non-motorized transportation opportunities in the Central Oklahoma region. This includes recreational trails, shared use paths, sidewalks, bicycle lanes, cycle tracks, safe bicyclist and pedestrian crossings, traffic control devices for pedestrians and bicyclists, and more.

There is a total of \$7.5 million available for projects located in the [ACOG Adjusted Urbanized Area \(UZA\)](#). Applicants may request between \$20,000 and \$1.5 million per project. Eligible TAP projects will be funded at a ratio of 80 percent federal funds and 20 percent local funds for eligible costs.

Entities that are eligible for this funding include:

- Local governments (towns, cities, and counties)
- Transit agencies
- Tribal governments
- Public school districts, public schools, or public universities (with support from local municipality)
- Non-profit organizations (with support from local municipality)

In order to be eligible for TAP funding, all prospective applicants must have submitted a pre-application form for each project by the pre-application deadline of Friday, September 16, 2022.

A completed CY 2021 Network Monitoring Survey must be submitted by the Call for Projects deadline in order to be considered for funding. The CY 2021 Network Monitoring Survey is available for download at: [https://www.acogok.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/Network-Monitoring-Survey\\_CY-2021.xlsx](https://www.acogok.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/Network-Monitoring-Survey_CY-2021.xlsx).

TAP applications that are submitted without a corresponding pre-application and completed CY 2021 Network Monitoring Survey will not be accepted. All required documents must be uploaded by the application deadline.
