MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

Dustin Downey called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. A quorum was present.

B. APPROVAL OF THE NOVEMBER 10, 2022, MEETING MINUTES

Dustin Downey made a motion to approve the November 10, 2022, minutes. Petya Stefanoff seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Correction on last month's minutes for Yukon: Julie Shannon said they are working on their Development Code, not Comprehensive Plan.

C. ITEMS FOR INFORMATION ONLY:

1. Accessory Dwelling Unit Discussion

Dustin Downey provided a presentation and led a discussion on Accessory Dwelling Units. The presentation can be viewed here: https://www.acogok.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/03/Accessory-Dwelling-Units.pdf.

2. 2022 Residential and Commercial Building Permit Request

Hannah Nolen highlighted the information provided in the agenda memorandum. Ms. Nolen stressed to the committee that ACOG staff would like the information by Friday, April 7, 2023.

3. 2023 Bike Month

Hannah Nolen said May is National Bike Month, sponsored by the League of American Bicyclists. Ms. Nolen noted that BikeFest will be held on Sunday, May 7, at Wheeler Ferris Wheel from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Bike to Work Week will take place May 15 - 21, 2023, and Bike to Work is Friday, May 19.

D. UPDATES FROM MEMBERS

Erik Brandt said they are working with the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) on an audit of their stormwater program. There is a slowdown in development due to the economy.

Robert Porton with Noble said developments are breaking ground despite the economy. They changed their stormwater management plan due to a poor audit.

Dan Kassik with Guthrie said they have four new subdivisions in process, and 890 lots will be added to the community by the end of this year or early next year.

Sasha McCrone with Oklahoma City said they are still working on code updates. They are also working on bikewalkokc and are close to wrapping it up. Ms. McCrone said a list of projects for next Oklahoma City's GO bond is a couple of years away. The transportation team is working on a project request list, including pedestrian bridges and sidewalks.

Petya Stefanoff with Midwest City said the GO bond project of Atkinson Park is completed. Mid-America Park is being worked on as well. They have another GO bond project that was postponed due to COVID. The Trail Master Plan is being updated and the City Council has

the ambition to be the trail capital of Oklahoma. They are also working on several studies to improve corridors.

Ken Nelson with The Village said Bruce Stone retired in January after 37 years, and they have a new City Manager. The Village passed a bond for more sidewalks and parks. They have a Planned Unit Development (PUD) project with Habitat for Humanity to put four houses on land that was donated by a church.

Sam Adams with Tinker Air Force Base said they have added new jobs and are working on an Airfield District Plan.

Julie Shannon with Yukon said development is slowing down. Yukon is running out of land space as they have so many floodplains and they are looking at more redevelopment in their code update. They are taking their code update to the council next month, and hopefully it will be adopted by June 1.

Devon Westbrook with Newcastle said they are working on their comprehensive plan update and hoping to wrap up in six months. Mr. Westbrook said they sent out an RFQ this month to update zoning, sign, and subdivision regulations. He said development has not slowed down and they are also working on a modeling study for stormwater. They have two commercial projects going on and two new subdivision plats being reviewed.

Joyce Green with Norman said the city offices moved to a different building. Last month, they passed new engineering design standards. They are looking at their comprehensive and infrastructure plan updates and they are negotiating contracts that will kick off in May.

Jan Fees with Edmond said their city office moved last week. Edmond is working with consultants on zoning, subdivision, and stormwater code updates. Ms. Fees said a ULI panel came to Edmond last month and did a study of downtown Edmond. Ms. Fees said most of the development in Edmond is downtown, with 500 apartments under development.

Brian Wint with Cleveland County said they have a new juvenile detention center that will open this summer. Once they vacate the existing facility, it will become a juvenile mental health center and high-risk alternative school. Their fairground project is ongoing as well.

Dustin Downey with El Reno said they have slowed down on residential growth, but it is picking back up again. Mr. Downey said he talked with one of the existing developers and they are building near Lake El Reno which adds additional housing types. Mr. Downey said the Lake El Reno walking trail broke ground in the first phase and the city has an application in for the second phase. He said in their park survey, 80 percent of respondents wanted the walking trail to go all the way around the lake. They broke ground on the fiber project and in the next four to five months they will be able to offer high speed internet to residents.

Staff requests single-family, multi-family, group quarters (nursing homes/retirement homes), and new business permits for **calendar year 2022**. If communities have demolition permits, staff would appreciate that information as well. GIS files are preferred, but staff will also accept Excel files.

Examples of data features that would be helpful include: type of permit, address, date of permit, number of units, company name, and ZIP code. Additional information is always welcome.
