The ACOG Public Fleet Conversion Grants Program helps cities and towns **replace gas** and diesel vehicles with clean fuel options — including electric, hybrid, CNG, propane, and hydrogen — and build fueling infrastructure.

ACOG reimburses up to 80% of the cost for eligible refueling infrastructure projects. You supply the 20% local match. For fleet vehicles, ACOG covers the incremental price difference between a gas/diesel vehicle vs an alternative fuel vehicle.

Think electric police cruisers, CNG refuse trucks, hybrid utility vehicles, and EV charging hubs at your yard and in your community.

- Light, medium, and heavy-duty alternative fuel vehicles
- Hybrid and plug-in hybrid replacements
- EV chargers or CNG/propane infrastructure
- Off-road equipment (e.g., mowers)

YOU'RE ELIGIBLE IF YOU ARE:

- Cities, towns, counties, or utilities within the ACOG MPO boundary
- Private contractor providing services like trash collection for eligible entities (via a Public-Private Partnership)
- · Public school district

- Only new replacement vehicles are eligible
- Projects must meet emissions and cost-effectiveness criteria
