MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER - INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS

Presiding Chair Brent Hawkinson called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES - DECEMBER 2, 2025, MEETING

Russell Anderson moved to approve the September 9, 2025, minutes of the ACOG RPAC meeting. Assistant. Chief Chris Sevier seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

3. ITEMS FOR INFORMATION ONLY

A. NG911 IMPLEMENTATION STATUS REORT

Mr. Hawkinson stated that as acted upon in the October 30, 2025, Board Meeting, the 911 ACOG and NGA911 contract would not be extended and would therefore expire on December 31, 2025. ACOG 911 staff have begun negotiations with another ESInet and NGCS provider. Additional information will be provided at the December 2025 and January 2026 Board meeting. Mr. Hawkinson acknowledged it has been a long road and appreciate the patience from the ECCs. It has also been difficult for staff as well as the ECCs. We look forward to moving forward and will not implement anything that is not 100% accurate.

B. 911 ACOG GRANT PROGRAM

Mr. Hawkinson mentioned the highlights of the new grant program stating the competitive program is administered through an application process welcomed any questions the attending ECCs might have. Mr. Hawkinson introduced Robin McDonald, the new 911 Administrative Assistant, and Chief Jeff Choate, Rural Fire Coordinator, as the administrators of the 911 Grant Program. The grant timeline as well as explanation of eligible ECCs was also mentioned.

C. 911 TECHNICAL SYSTEMS PROJECTS

Kale Littlefield said his team has been doing the monthly map updates and a router prioritization configuration is upcoming. Mr. Hawkinson assured the members in attendance that the upcoming configuration would provide the automatic fail-over coverage we are used to and need.

D. 911 TRAINING/SCHEDULE

Robin Murray highlighted the upcoming 911 Training and Schedule. Ms. Murray reminded the attendees that the 2026 Training Schedule was emailed to the ECCs. If there is a class for a subject you would like to address and do not see it in the current listing, please bring it to Ms. Murray or Kristin Gonul's attention and they will make it happen. The Oklahoma 911 Management Authority approved ACOG's 40-hour Basic Telecommunicator Course which certifies us to teach the course. Our course mirrors the APCO class but focuses on Oklahoma. Upon successful completion of the course the student will be certified. Textbooks, power points and tests are still in process.

E. RECENT 911 GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS (GIS) ACTIVITIES

Tanner Jones stated that the 911 GIS staff has sent our data to GeoComm to be analyzed for the yearly data audit. Those results are anticipated soon and then we will begin correcting any errors found in data. All ACOG ECC's have either uploaded their data to the 911 states repository or have a vendor or plan to get that data uploaded. If any entities need their data, let him know and he can add you to the monthly distribution list. The 911 GIS staff is again preparing the map updates so the latest GIS data will be available for the Guardian workstations and for the 911 dispatchers. The GIS data that will be distributed to the workstations will have the same up to date information that is in the ACOG GIS database. Tanner Jones also stated the monthly GIS data push to the GIS PSAP contacts was going out that day. If you need access or have any questions about the data, please let Tanner or his team know. Also, as always, our cell tower routing updates, address requests, MSAG information updates, road additions and changes, and subdivision requests are ongoing. If your community has any updates or changes needed for GIS, please let our GIS staff know.

4. ECC UPDATE

Mandy Mason said Moore has one open dispatcher position.

Assistant Chief Chris Sevier stated all is going well in Noble.

Russell Anderson said Norman has one dispatcher position open.

Christie Jaggie stated Edmond has two openings with one being filled next week. They are not using Criticalll testing, they have built their own testing.
